

4 Steps Child Passenger Safety

1



Infant

Rear-facing to a **minimum** of one year **and** 20 lbs. Child should remain rear-facing to the maximum capability of the seat.

2



Toddler

Forward-facing in a child safety seat to the maximum capability of the child safety seat (40-65 lbs).

3



Booster

Booster seat using vehicle lap **and** shoulder belt until child reaches 4'9", up to 100 lbs (4-12 yrs).

4



Seat Belt

Vehicle seat belt should be used by all passengers above 4'9" in all seated positions.
